

## CARE OF AN ANIMAL FOLLOWING NEUTERING

- 1. Allow animal to adjust to being home before offering food or water.
  - a. Offer only a small amount of water this evening.
  - b. Feed one-half the normal food amount this evening- if the animal wants to eat.
- 2. Keep inactive and quiet for 10-14 days following surgery.
  - a. No running or jumping.
  - b. Avoid stairs and slippery floors (tile, laminate, hardwood, etc.).
  - c. Keep on leash while outdoors.
- 3. Try to prevent licking and biting of the incision area.
